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to the COVID situation and the resulting disruption to school, the reports this semester will not include grades or attendance information. You will receive a letter with the report detailing the COVID reporting response from the school. We will be planning parent/teacher interviews using both Zoom and phone calls. These will follow after the reports have been released.

<u>Next Term:</u> Will see a return to greater normality at Coomealla High, providing the COVID response continues to be successful. We are still considering the future of some overnight excursions for Semester Two and will look at making some cautions initial steps early next term. Interschools sport will be allowed to continue, however, the recommencement of interschool sport will be determined by the easing of restrictions by the Victorian schools. We are hopeful for and are planning for the Year 12 graduation to go ahead. Stage 4 and 5 sport will return to Friday afternoons.
