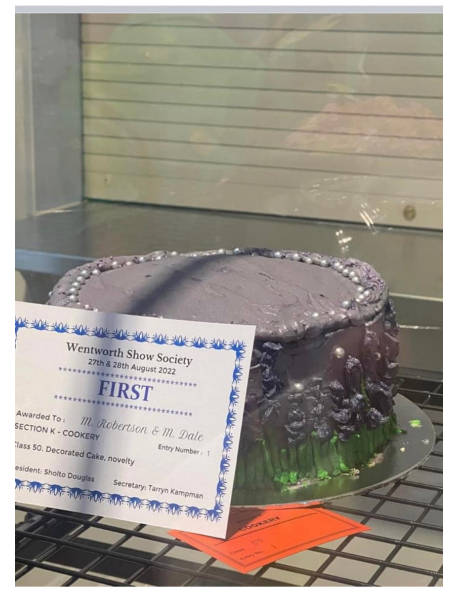

# CDC Community Notice



## Did you know that buses have right of way when departing from a bus stop?

Our bus drivers have an important job supporting the community, whether it is taking our kids to and from school, getting our friends and family to their jobs, or even offering an alternative to access shops and services around Mildura. Doing all of this safely is important to us and what helps us, is our fellow road users following the simple rule to give way to buses and ensuring they enter and exit bus stops safely.

*You will see a reminder like this on the back of our buses:*



### *An extract from the Road Safety Rules - 2017* **Road rule #77: Giving Way to Buses**

The road rule states when buses depart bus stops  
"A driver driving on a length of road in a built-up area, in the left lane or left line of traffic, or in a bicycle lane on the far-left side of the road, **must give way to a bus** in front of the driver if;

- (a) The bus has stopped, or is moving slowly, at the far-left side of the road, on a shoulder of the road, or in a bus stop.
- (b) The bus displays a give-way-to-bus sign.
- (c) The bus is about to enter or proceed in the lane or line of traffic in which the driver is driving."

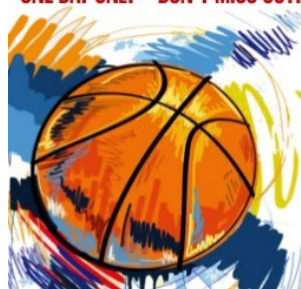
